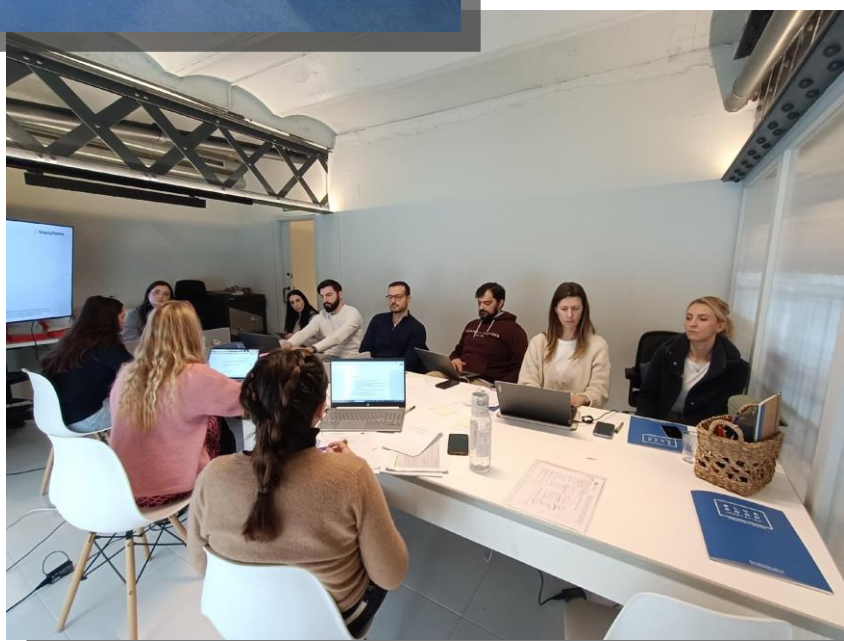
Palermo: Launching Collaboration and Shared Vision



On 7–8 May 2025, the TRANSFORM partnership met in Palermo, Italy, for the project's first in-person gathering. The meeting marked an important first step, offering partners the opportunity to move from proposal to practice and to begin building a shared direction for the project, active in 7 European countries. Across two days of discussion and exchange, the partnership laid the foundations for a collaborative and participated process shaped by dialogue, complementary expertise, and a common ambition to support more inclusive and resilient pathways in the labour market for both individuals and small and medium enterprises.

Girona: Building on Progress Together

On 28–29 January 2026, the TRANSFORM partnership met in Girona, Spain, for its second in-person project meeting. If Palermo marked the beginning of a shared path, Girona represented a moment of consolidation: a chance to reflect on what had been achieved, examine the work still in progress, and shape the next steps together. The meeting created space for both review and perspective, allowing partners to address challenges, exchange insights, and maintain a strong collective focus on the project’s wider aims. In doing so, it further strengthened the sense of cooperation at the heart of TRANSFORM and helped carry the project confidently into its next phase.

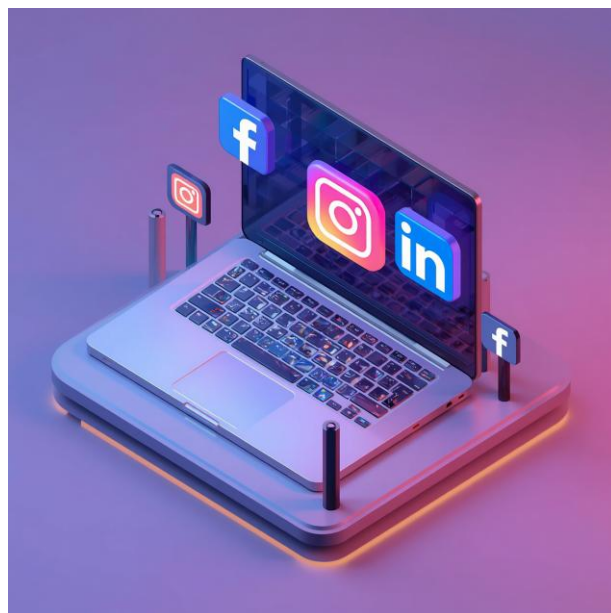
